CLIMATE JOBS STATEMENT ON TREASURY'S GUIDANCE ON ENERGY COMMUNITIES

Today, the U.S. Department of the Treasury released guidance related to implementation of the Inflation Reduction Act's incentives for clean energy investments in energy communities.
